
**Tools Required: Phillips Screwdriver, 9/16" or Adjustable Wrench**

**Tool Provided: Leveler Adjustment Key in the Zip bag taped to the Owner's Manual and Safety Guide.**

1. Turn the Top Assembly (Aa) upside-down on a clean, protected surface. Position the Legs (B) in the corners so the Insert Nuts (H) face in. LOOSELY attach with four 5/16" Flat Washers (E) and four 3/8" x 2-1/2" Hex Bolts (F) (the legs should be wobbly). See Figures 1 and 1a.




2. Turn the Shelf Assembly (C) upside-down and place the dowels into the dowel holes in the Legs. Tighten the Hex Bolts on the Legs. See Figure 2.

3. Using the pocket holes as guides, secure the Shelf (C) to the Legs (B) with eight #8 x 1-1/4" Pan Head Screws (D). See Figures 3 and 3a.



4. Turn the table upright and place the table at its final destination. Use the Leveler Adjustment Key (P), found in the Zip bag taped to the Owner's Manual and Safety Guide to rotate the Slotted Levelers (O) on the bottoms of the legs until the table is level. See Figures 4 and 4a.
